



Learning Focus

The focus this month is for children to:

1. Learn the five senses.
2. Develop a vocabulary of words to describe how things look, sound, smell, taste, and feel.
3. Continue their introduction to the letters of the alphabet and numbers.
4. Become comfortable with the classroom routine.
5. Increase their ability to talk with the teacher and other children.

1st Week

- Talk about the things we see every day in our classroom and at home.
- Learn the letters of the alphabet and numbers
- Learn to compare things by looking at them.

2nd Week

- Make a sound journal of the sounds we hear in the classroom and on the playground
- We will listen to animal sounds and the sounds of musical instruments.

3rd Week

- Learn about the sense of smell and taste. We will write recipes of our favorite foods, taste different foods, and make a graph of everyone's favorite foods.
- Identify different smells and talk about smells we like.

4th Week

Experiences with touching different textures in the Learning Centers.
